





2. DE-AT BZB project status

Reminder last meeting & questions raised



In the last meeting (26/06/2017) between Market Associations and DE-AT BZB SG, a few questions were raised by DE-AT TSOs for which feedback was requested to take into account in the project.

- 1. What is the position of Market Parties related to PTR and FTR?
- 2. What is the view of Market Parties on the preference for the external parallel run:
 - 1. Provide realistic bids for both bidding zones
 - 2. DE-AT NEMOs to split the operational bids
- 3. What are their views on the added value of the external // run and the preference of the duration (max 3 months)

Feedback provided by Market Associations

- 1. Preference for PTR
- 2. Provide realistic bids for both bidding zones
- 3. Maximum duration of // run

Status/feedback from the DE-AT BZB Project

- 1. DE-AT TSOs are asked by DE-AT NRAs to prepare the implementation of Physical Transmission Rights
- 2. Ability for Market Parties to provide realistic bids will be further discussed with the relevant NEMOs
- 3. The aim for the duration of external parallel run would be to maximize this period (max 3 months)
